The Arab-Israeli War of 1967 left hundreds of thousands of Palestinians homeless and impoverished. As various international entities struggled to respond, a small group of concerned Americans began working to provide immediate assistance to the victims of the conflict.

Today, Anera is non-political, non-religious, and one of the largest American nonprofit organizations operating in the Middle East.

The organization combines emergency relief with long-term programs in health, education, food and water security, and economic development, rooted in grassroots solutions for lasting impact.

Anera's operations encompass Palestine (West Bank, Gaza), Lebanon and Jordan.

All of Anera's Middle East staff come from the communities they serve.

Community Development: Improving livelihoods, providing renewable energy, delivering sports programs and more.

Education: Providing vulnerable people with academic, vocational and life skills for brighter futures.

Emergency Relief: Delivering food, water, medicine, shelter, healthcare, psychosocial support and more in crises.

Health: Supplying clinics and hospitals with medicine, infrastructure and trained personnel to improve health services.

Water & Sanitation: Installing networks to ensure safe, drinkable water and reliable sewage processing in underserved areas.
