

West Bank COVID-19 Situation Report


March 3, 2021

Overview

To date, there have been 185,338 confirmed COVID-19 cases in Palestine. Of these, 167,744 people have recovered and 2,058, tragically, have died. In the West Bank, there are now 15,536 active cases. The first case in the West Bank was confirmed on March 3, 2020, nearly one year ago.

The number of confirmed cases has rapidly increased to the point where some of the hospital occupancy rates reached 100%, especially in the southern and central governorates (Ramallah, Hebron, and Bethlehem).

Out of the 15,536 active cases, there are 116 patients in intensive care units — 29 of them requiring ventilation. The number of tests conducted in the West Bank has increased by 25% during the period from February 19th to the 25th, to 38,666.²



Key highlights from the Palestinian Ministry of Health (MoH) press releases:

- The West Bank is experiencing a third wave of COVID-19 cases, with deaths involving younger age groups that do not have a history of disease. The MoH is awaiting the arrival of two million doses of the AstraZeneca vaccine.
- The government decided to separate the southern areas of the West Bank from the central and northern areas to prevent the spread of the disease.
- There is full occupancy at the Palestine Medical Complex in Ramallah. The MoH therefore closed the hospital's outpatient clinics and converted them into special departments to provide healthcare services to coronavirus patients. The ministry did the same at Hugo Chavez Hospital, north of Ramallah.
- Authorities have closed the main entrances to all West Bank cities and educational institutions for two weeks.

Vaccines

Authorities expect the delivery of 37,440 doses of the Pfizer/BioNTech vaccine to arrive sometime in March. Frontline health workers will be priority recipients for vaccination from these doses. A further allocation of 240,000 doses of the AstraZeneca vaccine will come in several more shipments.⁴

- Providing ambulance services when needed
- Promoting awareness of how to deal with the pandemic
